What I am using

- Knoppix 3.9 in “Demo-Mode”
- Data on the USB memory key
- KDE desktop
- Open Office 2.0 Impress

“Automatic for the People”

- Provides a fully-functional Linux Desktop on PCs without claiming hard drive space.
- Easy enough to use as a demo
- Powerful enough for SysAdmins
- Detects many most hardware PC
- Configure many services on the fly
- Lots of applications, including cool games
- Documentation in German, English, and many other languages

You can't please everyone

- No support for non-pc hardware (MACs, SUNs, SGIs etc.)
- You can install on the hard drive but it's not easy
- Older hardware runs with limitations
- Not good for deploying a permanent server
- Can't optimized for CPU performance

Debian-Based

- The “Debian” install option for those who install to the hard drive is quite close to the Linux distribution as provided by the Debian project.
- Kpackage allows users to use apt-get to download upgrades and new packages

3 uses

- Temporary boot
 - Try before you buy
 - Use it on someone else's computer
- Preparing for another Linux distribution installation
 - Qt Parted to manipulate partitions
 - Hardware detection “lsmode”
- System administration tools...

System Administration Tools

- Allows you to “rescue” a pre-existing OS (Linux or Windows).
 - Mount your disks RW and fix broken configuration files
 - Use “fsck” to repair many different file system types
 - Boot loader repair
 - Data retrieval, scp it elsewhere
- Memtest86 test your RAM
- Nessus helps you do a security audit

Other Knoppix Versions

- Knoppix 4.0 DVD
- Knoppix 3.7 was the last version with the 2.4 kernel
- Gnoppix for GNOME
- KnoppMyth for a simple MythTV solution
- KnoppiXMAME for arcade game emulation
- Knoppix-STD for security tools
